Medications of any kind MUST be checked in with the Camp Staff on your camper's first day of camp.

LOST & FOUND:

Please write your camper's name on all of their belongings! We make every effort to return misplaced items to their rightful owners. You can also periodically check our Lost & Found table for your child's belongings.

TREATS & COOKING PROJECTS:

Included in our camp program are Friday cooking projects. A list of planned ingredients is available upon request 48 hours prior to the planned project. Furthermore, campers may be offered small treats like a piece of candy or a frozen popsicle. Any food related allergies or special diet considerations should have been noted in your registration under Health Concerns.

SAFE AND SECURE:

We have a safe and secure campus! Visitors must check in at the Main Office. Entrances are coded and available to registered families only. Campers who demonstrate aggressive

behavior will be sent home and their camp day voided.

ILL IESS POLICY:

All staff and children MUST stay home when feeling ill, or running a fever. If a child appears ill while at camp, they may be asked to get picked up. Campers must be symptom free, without the use of medicines, for 24 hours before returning to camp. Refer to the "Camp Illness Policy" for more details.

DROP OFF & PICK UP:

Curbside Hours: 8:00-8:30 am & 3:45-4:30 pm

During curbside hours, a staff member will be available to receive campers at the curb in front of campus. Other times during camp hours, families must park and walk onto campus to the Check In Desk or in the Main Office. All campers must be checked in and out using the Brightwheel App.

Any adult attempting to pick up without the Brightwheel App must be on the camper's approved pick up list and will be asked to show a photo ID.

MORNING CARE & EXTENDED CARE (CLUB):

Morning Care 7:30 am-8:00 am, is offered at no extra charge. Drop off is at Room 11. Parents must park and escort their camper in, then Check In via Brightwheel with the Staff member.

Extended Care (CLUB) 4:30 pm-5:30 pm, is offered at an additional charge and must be registered for the Monday prior to attendance. Any campers staying past 4:30, who are not registered, will be assessed the emergency rate of \$25/day.
