SWIMMING LESSONS SUMMER 2024

Ages: Children must be at least 3 years of age and completely potty trained in order to participate. Swim lessons are conducted by one instructor with 1-3 students of similar age and ability.

Little Ranch / Big Ranch / Swim Lessons:

- Lessons will usually be conducted between 2:30-4:00 PM.
- \$165.00 for 5 lessons.
- After submitting this form, you will receive a link to sign up for the days you wish your child to receive their lesson.
- Your child must be enrolled in camp on the day of their lesson.
- *Unused swim lessons cannot be returned for refund or credit.*

Preschool Swim Lessons:

- Lessons are conducted from 10:00-11:45 AM
- Due to swim instruction ratios, there is limited availability. Sign up with preschool office for specific lesson times.
- \$165.00 for 5 lessons. **Reserve your lesson time with your preschool director.**
- *Unused lessons cannot be returned for refund or credit.*

Instruction is given by aquatics staff, which have Red Cross Lifesaver and/or Water Safety Instructor (WSI) certification.
